D'Iberville Chief of Police Wayne Payne announced the arrest of Christopher Ryan Fayard, W/M 31 years of age of D'Iberville.

On June 15, 2009, D'Iberville Police Officers responded to a complaint of shoplifting at the D'Iberville WalMart. Upon arrival, officers found Fayard to be in possession of two hundred Hydrocodone pills. Officers arrested Fayard and charged him with misdemeanor shoplifting and felony Possession of a Controlled Substance.

Chief Payne said one of his main focuses is reducing drugs in the D'iberville community. Chief Payne plans to accomplish this task by continuing partnership with The Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics and officer overtime pursuant to federal and state grants, therefore, saving the City money.

Captain Keith Davis said Fayard was incarcerated in the Harrison County Adult Detention Center under a \$10,000.00 bond set by Harrison County Justice Court Judge Albert Fountain.
