Rules and Regulations

All cook-off teams are required to submit an entry form for the event. The entry form entitles one (1) Adult team the use of one cook-off space (10ft x 20ft) at the rate of \$75.00 for the Backyard Division & \$150.00 for the Professional Division. Make checks payable to the D'Iberville Gateway Group and mail to, PO Box 6753, D'Iberville MS 39540 or you may drop your entry off at the D'Iberville City Hall at 10383 Automall Parkway, D'Iberville MS 39540.

Electrical (110 amp) and/or water hookups are available on a first come first serve basis for a single fee of \$25.00.

Team entry deadline: All Professional Division Entries must be received no later than February 24, 2016 by 5pm. Backyard and Piglet (Youth) Entries will be accepted until February 26th, 2016 by 5pm.

1. **Team competition:** Each adult team will consist of 1 team captain and up to 4 team members. Each registered team must have their captain/parent attend the BBQ Throw-down mandatory meet and greet on Friday, February 26th, 2016 at 7pm at the Civic Center.
2. **BBQ categories and rules:** There will be three (3) categories judged in two (2) divisions: Port Spare Ribs, Chicken (half of a whole chicken), Brisket in Professional and Backyard divisions. To qualify for Grand Champion in either division, all three (3) categories must be entered by a team. All cooking must be done on site. Meat must be kept at 38 degrees or lower prior to cooking.
3. **Judging:** Categories will be judged on the basis of:
A.) Appearance B.) Texture C.) Taste
Each team must provide enough BBQ for all judges.

Turn in times will be confirmed at the Cooks Meeting on February 26th, 2016

Pulled Pork Taste Tent: For a \$10.00 entry fee, Pulled Pork Taste Tent contestants may compete by providing *at least* 10 pounds of pulled pork. Winners will be judged by popular vote.

4. **Set-up Time:** Each team is required to supply its own equipment for the Throw-down. Both gas and charcoal grills are allowed in the Backyard Division only. Professional Division Competitors must comply with BCA cooking regulations. See www.bcabbq.org for a complete list. Open flame pits or primitive fires are not allowed. Teams are allowed to set-up on Friday February 26th, after noon, as security will be provided. All set-ups must be completed no later than 8:30 am, Saturday, February 27th. No vehicles will be allowed near the cooking spaces between 8:30am and 4:30pm on Saturday, February 27th.

Team equipment and decorations must fit within the area assigned. A fire extinguisher must be supplied by each team. Each team is required to have sanitizers for hands and equipment available onsite. For a complete list of BCA rules, go to www.bcabbq.org.

6. Behavior and Conduct: This is a community event. Any negative or unruly conduct will be cause for removal from the event grounds. The event site is in close proximity to a residential neighborhood. Please keep the noise level to a minimum from 11pm-6am. Thank you for your consideration.

7. Housekeeping: Each team will be expected to *police* their space and surrounding area for trash.

Trashcans will be supplied but we strongly suggest bringing extra trash liners for the event.

8. Clean-up/Breakdown: All teams are responsible for the clean-up and break-down of any and all props, decorations, cooking utensils, equipment and trash in and around their space. Any property left at the event after 6pm will be considered trash and thrown away.

Any violation of any of the aforementioned rules will be grounds for disqualification and dismissal from the event. The City of D'Iberville and /or the D'Iberville Gateway Group and any volunteer will not be held responsible for any accident(s), theft, or damage to person(s) and /or equipment.

Note: For confirmation of turn-in schedule, question & answer session, and other important information, all teams are required to attend the Meet and Greet on Friday February 26th, @ 7PM. Dinner & refreshments will be served.
