Please note: The following restrictions are specific to the City of D'iberville regarding this application, failure to comply with these restrictions will result in your permit being rescinded. A 48-hour notice will be required prior to the moving of any homes, trailers, wide loads, etc.

- \* During all moving operations, movers will allow for the passing of emergency vehicles during this move.
- \* A copy of any current MDOT permit (or other municipality permit) must be submitted with this application.
- \*All traffic control must be coordinated through the D'ibeville police department prior to the 48 hour required notice.
- \* All necessary provisions will be taken to assure that traffic in the moving area will not be obstructed for more than 15 minutes. At <u>no</u> time will the traffic be allowed to be obstructed for a period of more than 30 minutes.
- \* During all moving operations, the mover will secure the use of law enforcement officers to facilitate the safe movement of the load.
- \* All trees that will require trimming or removing, must first be permitted through the city. This application is available in the building department.
- \* No moving operation shall be conducted during times of hazardous weather conditions.
- \* No moving operation will be allowed outside of the permitted route (s).
- \* Moving operation will only be allowed from daylight to dusk (no exceptions).
- \* Any traffic control devices (signs, etc.) may be removed just prior to passing of the permitted item, these must be re-erected immediately after the passing of the permitted item. The traffic control devices must be re-installed within the previous location to its original conditions.
- \* Escorts will be required at the front and rear of the item being moved, with communications between the escorts and the moving vehicle.
- \* Proper flagging of the item being moved is required. (At all corners of item).
- \* Any load obstructing traffic must pull off the road periodically to allow traffic to clear.
- \* All vehicles used in the moving operation must be properly licensed, insured and of adequate size to handle the load being moved.
- \*A bucket truck will be required for all overhead work, proper safety photocalls must be adhered to when dealing with overhead wiring, etc.
- \* No traffic control devices shall be removed or altered. Just prior to the permitted item passing their location, a bucket truck shall be required to manually raise any signal support cables and hardware. The bottom cables may be disconnected, but shall be reconnected immediately after the permitted item has passed the location of the traffic control signal.
- \* The city will require a minimum 7 days for review and coordination of permit process.
- \* Licensed Electrician will be required when dealing with the traffic signal(s) dis-assembly/re-assembly.
