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<b>CONSUMER'S CONTRACT</b>

\_\_\_\_\_. In consideration thereof, this contract and agreement is entered into between the City of D'Iberville, hereinafter called the **City** and

\_\_\_\_\_ hereinafter called the **Consumer**.

**TERMS:**

The City agrees to furnish metered water through a(n) \_\_\_\_\_ - inch pipe line, connecting the consumer's pipes to the water system of the City. The contract is mutually exclusive and shall not apply to service at any other site, location or address unless a new contract and agreement is executed for such site, location or address.

The Consumer agrees that he/she will, within 60 days of being notified that sewer service is available within 300 feet of the site covered by this contract, connect and begin using the City's sewer system.

The Consumer hereby agrees and covenants with the City that the connections to the Water and/or Sewer systems and the use of Water and Sewer services shall be subject to the rules, rates, charges and regulations of the City of D'Iberville in force and effect on the date of this contract and as may hereinafter be adopted by resolution or ordinance of the Mayor and City Council and to pay for such services within ten (10) days of the monthly billing date. Payments can be made at the Water & Sewer Collection Department in City Hall. The rules, regulations and rates are considered as part of this agreement and contract.

The Consumer further agrees and covenants with the City that no one shall make any changes, additions or alterations or do any other work whereby the rates covered by this contract shall be altered or changed in any manner without first applying to the City Water & Sewer Department and receiving authorization in writing and further to file with the Water & Sewer Department of the City such report as may be required and further submitting a written order for such changes, additions or alterations properly signed and dated by the Owner of the premises covered by this contract or by the duly authorized agent of such Owner.

The Consumer further covenants and agrees that employees of the Water & Sewer Department of the City may enter upon the premises of the Consumer during regular business hours for the purpose of inspecting the water and/or sewer lines and appurtenances to insure the safe, reasonable and proper operation thereof and to make such adjustments, repairs or replacements of City-owned lines, meters or other appurtenances as, in the judgment of the City may be reasonable and proper. The Consumer agrees that any lines, meters, valves and/or other appurtenances that must be replaced or repaired will be the expense of the Consumer if such damages are due to willful negligence or malicious acts of the Consumer.

This Contract shall be effective from the date of execution until the first of October, following the date of execution and shall be automatically renewed yearly unless written notice to the contrary is given by either the City or Consumer. This contract shall not be binding unless executed by the City Clerk or his/her representative, designated in writing as an authorizing agent.

Bills for water service through meters and sewer service shall be issued monthly and on a flat rate basis monthly and while the City will make every reasonable effort to see that each Consumer receives a bill, no responsibility will be assumed for non-delivery when same has been mailed through the U. S. Post Office.

All charges for water services, either through meters or flat rates and/or for sewer service are due and payable the tenth (10th) day of the month following the month when the bill was issued.

All bills that have not been paid on or before the tenth (10th) of the month as described above are considered delinquent and pursuant to applicable ordinances of the City, such service for water and/or sewerage may later be discontinued or disconnected and charges or fees for reinstatement will be made in each instance in addition to the amounts which may otherwise be due.

All overdue or delinquent bills will each be assessed late fees or penalties as set out by applicable ordinances.

If billing is based on meter readings, water service will be metered as accurately as possible.

No claim or demand that the owner or Consumer may have against the City shall be considered as an offset against the payment for services furnished under these regulations.

The City agrees to use reasonable diligence in providing a regular and uninterrupted supply and water and sewer service, however interruptions in service due to accident or any other cause shall not place the City liable for such interruption or failure.

No additional service will be installed until a contract, clearly stating rates, charges etc...has been entered into.

Any service provided during the period will carry the proper minimum charge or billing for the portion of said period.

This contract is supplemented, amended and further governed by any and all applicable ordinances of the City as they may exist or be promulgated or amended from time to time.

These rules and regulations are referred to in and made a part of each contract for Water & Sewer service and are subject to amendment or change by the City of D'Iberville, Mississippi.

Applicable water tapping fees must be paid before work is done.

Applicable sewer tapping fees must be paid before work is done.

Applicable meter deposits must be paid before service is installed.
