The following items are accepted:

- \* Latex or oil based paint (5 gallon, 1 gallon, quarts and spray paint)
- \* Used cooking oil and Automobile Oil
- \* Antifreeze
- \* Household, Marine, and Car Batteries
- \* Aerosol cans
- \* Flammable Liquids (Such as Gasoline)
- \* White goods such as freezers, refrigerators, washing machines and dryers
- \* Fluorescent light bulbs
- \* Tires (up to 25 per household annually- strictly enforced)
- \* E-Waste (electronics) such as computers, cell phones, and televisions

The following items **WILL NOT** be accepted:

- \* Any item in a container larger than 5 (Five) gallons
- \* Herbicides
- \* Pesticides
- \* Asbestos
- \* Rubber Cement
- \* Roofing material
- \* Explosives (including flares)
- \* Pharmaceuticals
- \* Chemicals
- \* Construction debris
- \* Furniture
- \* Or commercial waste (business- only household waste can be accepted)
