

# SOLID WASTE COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Do not place piles or items for collection under power lines or tree limbs, and please keep away from mailboxes, fire hydrants and gas/electric meters.

**ALL SOLID WASTE WILL BE COLLECTED ON SAME DAY AS WEEKLY GARBAGE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION DAYS.**



Waste should be placed curbside, within 3-5 feet from curb

Waste should not block the roadway

## Misc. Waste

We will not pick up any unbagged household garbage, crawfish/shrimp hulls, concrete, asphalt, dirt, tires, batteries, household hazardous waste or refrigerators with Freon still inside. Freon must be removed by a licensed contractor and tag placed

## Vegetative Debris

Limbs should be cut no longer than 8ft in length  
Stumps or large logs cannot be picked up for collection

## Contractor Waste

No contractor-generated waste will be collected, which includes construction, tree services, lawn services or any other contracted service.

## Bagged Waste

Leaves, pine straw, and insulation must be bagged for collection.

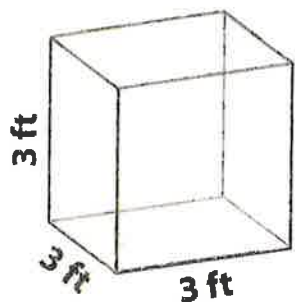
Pelican  
Waste & Debris



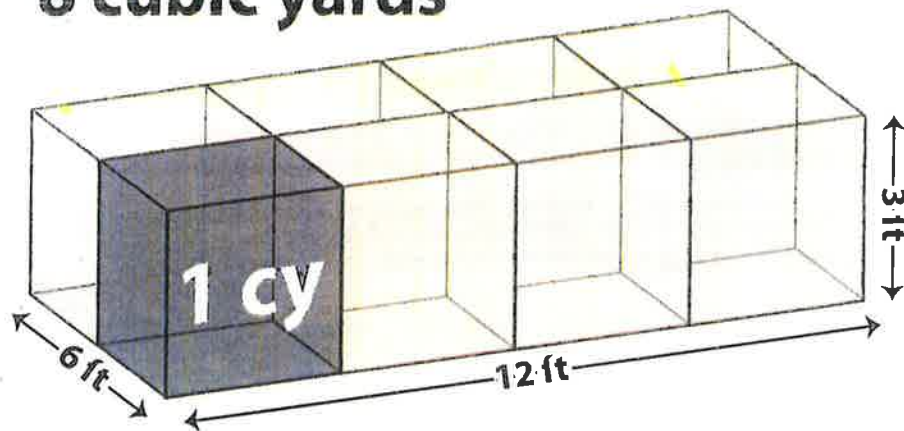
# Visual Representation of Eight (8) Cubic Yards

1 cubic yard (cy)

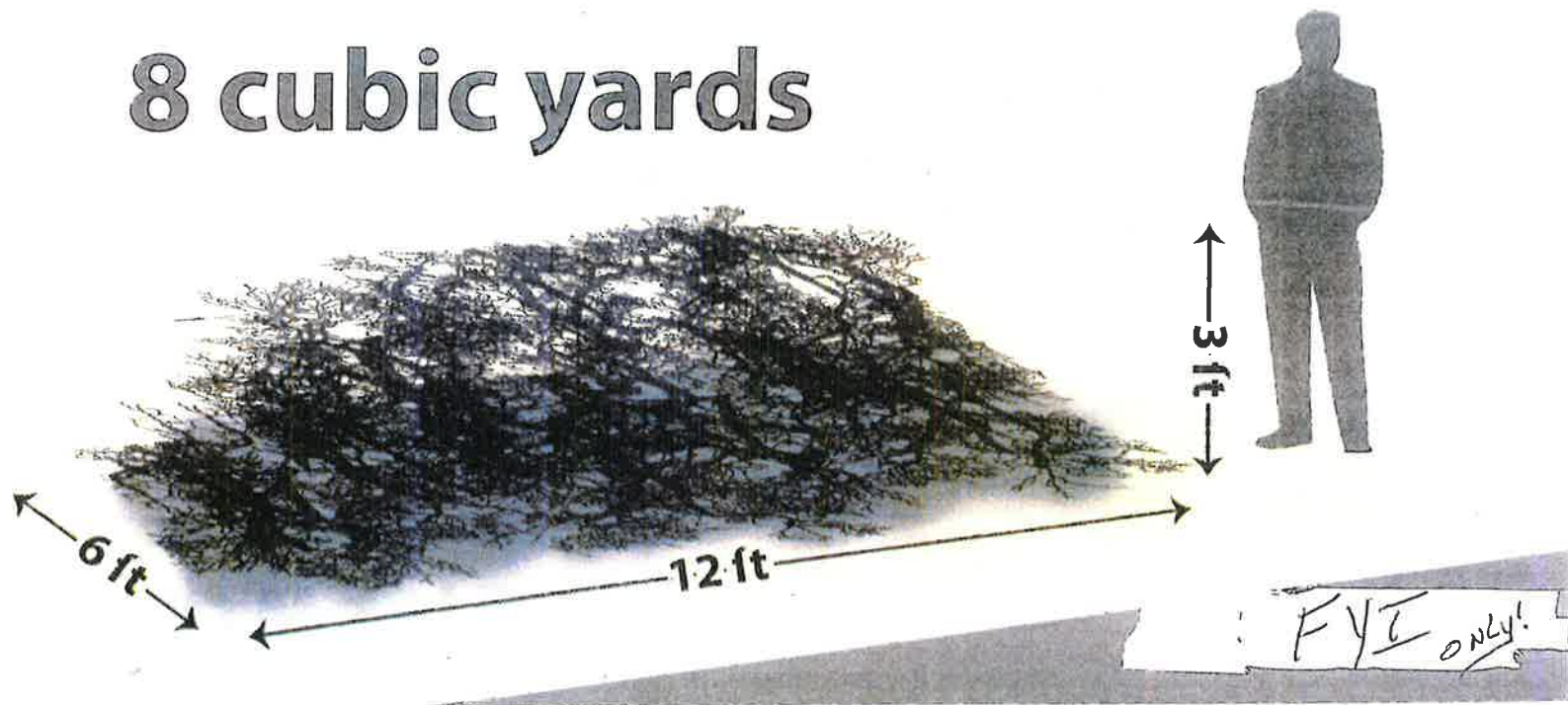

## ADDITIONAL "QUICK REFERENCE" NOTES!!

- a. Pelican Waste is not responsible for debris placed in front of vacant lots
- b. Pelican Waste is not responsible for contractor related debris
- c. Limbs should be 8' or shorter in length
- d. Pelican Waste picks up 8 cubic yards per address per service visit (large piles may take a few weeks to be 100% removed)
- e. Pelican Waste does not dispose of concrete or fencing with concrete
- f. There are special guidelines for freezers and refrigerators for disposal
- g. A brown trash cart is the first cart provided by Waste Management
- h. A second trash cart can be requested for a yearly cost and that cart is not brown
- i. Trash carts have ID chips and carts located at an unassigned location will not be emptied by Waste Management
- j. Trash carts at locations can be emptied only if a resident has valid utility services at that location and the residence is occupied
